

TEMPORARY CURBSIDE PICKUP ZONE PROGRAM

We know that the COVID-19 pandemic has placed an immense hardship on restaurants and small businesses in Plymouth. To support local businesses, we are offering to mark off temporary pick-up zones in front of establishments whose operations are now limited to takeout and delivery services. The quick pick-up zones will be placed along curbs in the downtown and on the waterfront where this is currently on-street metered or time-restricted parking.

A temporary pick-up zone will be created upon request and can be used for takeout and delivery vehicles only. If you are the owner or manager of a restaurant, bar, café or brewery/ liquor store or retail business located in the



downtown/ waterfront areas of Plymouth and would like a pick-up zone created along the curb in front of your business, please fill out the attached form and email it to degan@parkplymouth.com. Be sure to provide the business address, contact information, hours of pick-up and delivery operation, and the approximate number and location of the parking spaces you believe are needed to accommodate quick pickup and delivery services from your establishment. You must already have a pick-up or delivery service in place to qualify for this program. The pick-up zone permit will be created free of charge and will be valid for 21 days when it will need to be renewed.
